## Frequently Asked Questions

### **Who can apply for funding?**

Constituted community groups, limited companies, co-operatives or partnerships are all eligible to apply for funding from the Gaelic Projects Fund. Applications cannot be accepted from sole traders or from groups without a constitution and bank account. If you are unsure of your eligibility to apply for this Fund, please contact the Bòrd na Gàidhlig Grants' Officer.

### **What kinds of projects are eligible for assistance?**

Projects which fulfil the criteria of strengthening learning and usage of the Gaelic language in the home and/or among young people aged 12 – 24 years will be eligible for assistance from this Fund.

### **Does Gaelic have to be a part of the project?**

Gaelic must be an integral part of each project application made to the Fund. It is essential that each project receiving funding serves to increase the acquisition and usage of the Gaelic language in the **home** and amongst **young people**.

### **What is the link between the National Plan for Gaelic and the Togail agus Cleachdadh Gaelic Projects Fund?**

The Fund is directly linked to the National Plan for Gaelic through the priority areas of **acquisition of Gaelic in the home** and **the use of Gaelic in communities**.

Applicants are advised to consult the National Plan before completing their application to the Togail agus Cleachdadh Gaelic Projects Fund. The National Plan for Gaelic is available on the Bòrd's website [www.bord-na-gaidhlig.org.uk](http://www.bord-na-gaidhlig.org.uk).

**What is the maximum amount of funding awarded?**

£2,500 is the maximum amount of funding awarded for each project. Funding support received through the Gaelic Projects Fund requires to be substantially spent by 31<sup>st</sup> March 2008.

**When is the closing date for applications?**

Applications must be submitted to the Bòrd by 10<sup>th</sup> December 2007.

**Will there be other opportunities to apply to the Gaelic Projects Fund?**

This is a one-off Fund for financial year 2007-08.

**When will the outcome of applications be made known?**

The outcomes of the application assessment process will be mailed to applicants by 21<sup>st</sup> December 2007.
